Only complete this form if you are planning on sending your child to kindergarten in 2024. To be eligible for three-year-old kindergarten, your child must turn three by 30 April 2024.

As every child is different, we encourage you to carefully consider the year your child commences 3-year-old kindergarten, as this may have an impact on the year they commence school.

The Department of Education and Training has advised all services that there is not an option for families to do a second year of three-year-old kindergarten. It will be expected that you will register your child for four-year-old kindergarten in 2025.

Darebin City Council do not manage or operate any kindergartens or Long Day Care services.

The information you provide in this form will be shared with the kindergarten once you have accepted an offered place.

Kindergarten administration fee

We charge a one-off administration fee for the registration of each child. Administration fees are waived for eligible Australian Government concession card holders (see page 6 for list).

Priority of access

Kindergarten places are prioritised for children through the Department of Education and Training Priority of Access criteria. These include:

- Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander children
- Children at risk of abuse or neglect, including children in out-of-home care
- Asylum seeker and refugee children
- Children eligible for the kindergarten fee subsidy
- Children with additional needs: those who need extra assistance in order to fully participate in the kindergarten program, require a combination of services which are individually planned, or have an identified specific disability or developmental delay.

Darebin gives subsequent priority to the following:

- Families who are Darebin residents or whose child attends unregistered verified care in Darebin
- Had a child/sibling who attended the same kindergarten in the past 2 years
- First preference kindergarten is closest to the child's address
- Internal long day care children (who request the kindergarten program within their current long day care service)

Children that fit one or more of these criteria will be allocated to a place in kindergarten as priority. This form collects all the information required to determine if a child is eligible for Priority of Access. If you believe you or your child are in exceptional circumstances which require prioritisation and are not covered by any of the above criteria, please contact the Darebin Registration Team on 8470 8825.

Privacy
